INDOOR CRICKET

COMPETITION DATES

Competition begins on Wednesday 16 May, continues until 4 July, Resumes on 25 July and concludes on 22 August (13 playing days). August 29 is scheduled as a reserve day if required

VENUES Depending on the number of teams entered games may be played at one or each of the following venues:

TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

This competition will only go ahead if five or more teams enter.
Games will be **Action Cricket 6+**, which is fully endorsed by Canterbury and NZ Cricket
There are two Grades: Open (boys/girls/mixed teams of any age) and
Junior (boys/girls/mixed teams of students in Years 9-11)
Games last approximately one hour. Commencing at 3.15pm

UMPIRES

Umpires will be supplied by the venue.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment is supplied. White (non-marking) soled shoes are to be worn.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue.
Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.

RESULTS

All schools will be responsible for in-putting their own results directly into sports runner, by 1pm on the Thursday following each game.
Heads of Sport have the passwords and instructions re accessing this.

CANCELLATION

Cancellation will only occur in extreme weather conditions or school or venue closure
If a round of games is lost through cancellation, a new draw will be issued for the following week.
