Each player will require a racket and must wear non-marking, clean sports shoes all games will be self-umpired and scored

Probably time-based games rather than sets Round robin of games followed by play offs if time permits Must be given to the event controller at the end of each game Each team will provide a game quality ball Each school to provide a referee and scorer for each game
