



**CANTERBURY SECONDARY SCHOOLS GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS 2020**  
**INFORMATION SHEET NO 1**

**VENUE:** Coringa Country Club

**DATES:** Monday 21 September 2020

**COMPETITIONS AND GRADES:**

**A Grade:** Match play for teams of FOUR, and may be made up of all boys, all girls, or a combination of boys and girls. Competition is "off the stick". Participants will play four rounds of 9 holes. (entry numbers dependent)  
Restricted to 8 teams. All A grade players must have an official handicap.  
Boys play off blue tees, girls off white tees, when playing against boys.  
Multiple entries from a school may be permitted if there are insufficient A Grade teams from other schools.

**B Grade:** Match play for teams of FOUR, and may be made up of all boys, all girls, or any combination of boys and girls. Competition is "off the stick". Participants will play up to four rounds of 9 holes over the day (entry numbers dependent)  
Restricted to next best 8 teams,  
Boys play off white tees, girls off yellow tees.  
Multiple entries from a school may be permitted if there are insufficient B Grade teams from other schools

**C Grade:** Match play for teams of FOUR, and may be made up of all boys, all girls, or any combination of boys and girls. Competition is "off handicaps".  
Participants will play three or four rounds of 9 holes over the day depending on entry numbers  
Restricted to next best 8 teams, including multiple team entries from the same school. Boys play off white tees, girls off yellow tees.

**D Grade:** Match play for teams of FOUR, and may be made up of all boys, all girls, or any combination of boys and girls. Competition is "off handicaps".  
Participants will play three or four rounds of 9 holes over the day depending on entry numbers  
Boys play off Red tees girls off yellow tees.

The Sports Director's Office will, in consultation with schools, adjust entries into grades as deemed necessary to ensure viable competition in each grade. Generally this will be done by the total handicap of the 4 players listed in each team.  
Teams may comprise all boys, all girls, or teams of boys and girls. Girls will play off Ladies tees except A grade.

Students must be under the age of 19 years as 1 January 2020 and fulfil the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sport as defined by the NZSSS Council. Students in Years 7 & 8 are not eligible to participate. The SSC policy on the entry of composite teams will apply.
