

NETBALL - WEDNESDAY COMPETITION INFORMATION 2020

COMPETITION DATES

Competition begins on Wednesday 24 June continues until 1 July, resumes on 22 July and concludes on 16 September [11 playing days]. The competition format will be determined by the number of teams entered. Wednesday afternoon games will begin at 3.15pm, with a possible second round at 4.10pm to accommodate court restrictions.

VENUES

School gymnasiums; Hagley Park netball courts and School courts will be used.

Indicate if your courts can play two rounds at 3.15pm & 4.00pm on the entry form.

Two schools are rostered each week to do DUTY at Hagley. Duties include overseeing student behaviour, tidying court area after games, and collecting any lost property. It is further recommended that a particular team is named as the Duty Team by the Duty schools.

TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

There are nine grades: [ages as at 1 January 2020]

***SuperNet** an elite competition for the best eight teams in the region

***SuperNet Reserve**

for the next best eight teams from other schools, and B teams from SuperNet schools will have the opportunity to enter this grade should there be spaces, any age Under 19.

*2019 team placings will stand with no promotion / relegation for 2020.

A for teams of a high standard with players any age Under 19 who do not qualify for SuperNet and Super Net Reserve grades

B for teams of a high standard with players who may be less experienced/younger, any age Under 19

C for teams of average standard, any age Under 19

Junior for students who are in years 9 or 10, and who are under 15

Year 9 for students who are in Year 9 only

Junior Boys for boys who are in year 9 or 10 only

Mixed teams of all boys, all girls, or a combination of boys and girls of any age under 19.

ENTRIES

All entries can be done via the EnterNOW online entry package.

Link to www.enternow.co.nz/ssc/. These close on Monday 15 June @1.00pm.

UMPIRES

All teams in all grades are required to provide an umpire for each match, dual control. This means one umpire from each team is required, and the same umpires remain for the entire game. There is no switching between quarters or halves.

The only exception is the SuperNet grade in which official umpires are appointed. Failure to supply an umpire will result in the forfeit of the match. Only one official score is to be taken, score keepers are required to stand side by side during the match.

All round robin games, a drawn result is acceptable. For all playoff games a winner is required, with a team winning by 2 goals & within the international netball federation rules. All finals a winner is required.

EQUIPMENT

First named team provides the ball.
Position bibs are to be worn by all players.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Comply with indoor venues evacuation & risk management plans.

Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.

Covid-19 all Schools must adhere to the Alert Level requirements in place at each venue used. These may include specific hygiene requirements, contact tracing, social distancing and possibly gathering size.

JEWELLERY

No headwear (excluding NNZ approved sun visors), shorts longer than the length of skirt or dress, boxer shorts, jewellery or body piercing may be worn.

No item of jewellery (including body piercing), except a wedding ring and /or medical alert bracelet shall be worn. If either or both are worn, each shall be fully taped to the body. Cultural necklaces may be worn only if all parts are wholly taped to the body. Fingernails may not be taped nor be long; however suitable gloves may be worn for the entire game.

RESULTS

All schools are responsible for in-putting their own results directly into the SportsRunner draw package by 1.00 pm the day following each game [Thursday].

CANCELLATION

Netball is a Level Two cancellation, with notification via on website and APP.

If a round of games is lost through cancellation, a new draw will be issued for the following week.

COST

An entry fee of \$25.00 per team will be charged for the 2020 Wednesday competition for all grades except Super Net and Super Net Reserve. SuperNet entry fee will be \$125.00 per team. SuperNet Reserve entry fee will be \$75.00 per team.
