

# Selwyn Secondary School Combined Athletics Festival 2021



## INFORMATION

- VENUE:** Nga Puna Wai, Augustine Dr, Wigram, Christchurch 8025
- DATE:** Monday 1 March 2021 (proposed new date)
- TIME:** The meet will start with an Officials and Managers meeting at 9.30am.  
The programme will commence *promptly* at 10.00am and should finish by 2.45pm.  
There will be an officials/manager meeting at 9.20am.
- CANCELLATION:** If necessary, an email will be sent to all school managers before 7.30am on the day.
- FOOTWEAR:** Spikes may be worn for all events. Starting blocks will be supplied.
- GRADES:** As at 1 January 2021  
Junior- U14 / U 15  
Senior- U16/ U19  
Open- U19
- EVENTS:** Track: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, Medley Relay.  
Field: High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump (Open), Shot Put, Discus, Javelin (Open)  
This year throwing events will be held on the back-training field due to the inner field being out for touch national preparation).  
Fun Event: Tug O War (more information included below).  
Medley Relay- 100m, 200m, 100m, 400m:  
There will be a medley relay this year instead of the traditional 4x100. We will run both a Junior (Yr. 9 – 10) and a Senior (Yr. 11 – 13) race.  
This will be held in the middle of the field. The race must consist of 2 Males and 2 Females. Males and Females can run any leg in the race. The race starts the same as a 4x100m relay at the start line. The second runner will receive the baton at the 300m start. Third runner around the 100m start line and fourth runner at the 4x100m start. Team must stay in their lanes.
- PROGRAMME:** This will be emailed to schools when completed so it can be posted on school websites/ Facebook pages following entry closure.
- ENTRIES:** All entries will be taken online and must be completed by 10am 25<sup>th</sup> February.  
Bill will send out a link and any information schools need to know about entries. You will need your **edp password** to access the entries website. All schools have these and hopefully know where to access them.

**TUG O WAR:** During the lunch time period there will be tug of war challenge between the schools.

We will run both a Junior (Yr 9 – 10) and a Senior (Yr 11 – 13) competition.  
This will be held in the middle of the field.

The Rules:

8 members per team.  
Teams to be evenly mixed (4 boys & 4 girls)

The Format:

This event will run as a straight semifinal round with the winners facing off in a final and a 3rd and 4th placing match.

We will run 2 matches at the same time to allow all teams to have a matching rest period.

Semi Final Rnd 1:

Lincoln Jnr Vs. Darfield Jnr  
Rolleston Jnr Vs. Ellesmere Jnr

Final 1:

1st & 2nd Final (Winners of Rnd 1)  
3rd & 4th Final (Losers of Rnd 1)

Semi Final Rnd 2:

Lincoln Snr Vs. Darfield Snr  
Rolleston Snr Vs. Ellesmere Snr

Final 2:

1st & 2nd Final (Winners of Rnd 2)  
3rd & 4th Final (Losers of Rnd 2)

**Please note that the online system will only allow a max. of 3 events per student Any additional entries will need to be made directly to the Sports Director by email. A template form will be made available for these additional entries. Please consider the welfare of the students in entering additional events.**

**Last year a large number of entered competitors did not turn up on the day. This made running the track events extremely difficult. Please be mindful of this when entering your students into events.**

#### **FOR CANTERBURY SECONDARY SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Following the event, each school will be responsible for entering students into the Canterbury Secondary Schools championships.

To do this, schools will need to go back to the on-line entry package and **delete all students who will not be entered** into the Canterbury event, leaving only those who you do want to enter.

Changes to events will be possible. Please check the entry restrictions for the Canterbury event.

## **PARTICIPATING SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS**

This event can only take place with the support of all schools. Each participating school will be assigned a responsibility for this event.

**OFFICIALS:** It is an entry requirement for every school that enters this event to supply the officials whether they are teachers, parents or senior students at their event. Each school is responsible for providing **senior pupils or parents** to assist them in the running of their field event(s).
