

## SQUASH

### WEDNESDAY COMPETITION - WINTER 2021

#### COMPETITION DATES

Competition begins on Wednesday 19 May continues until 7 July, resumes on 28 July and concludes on 18 August [12 playing days]. The competition format will be determined by the number of teams entered. Games begin at 3.15pm.

#### ENTRY

To be entered via EnterNOW system by the close of entries date of Monday 10 May 1.00pm.

#### VENUES

School and Club Courts - see separate list.

#### TEAM AND GRADE CONDITIONS

Teams consist of 3 players in order of playing strength with boys, girls, or mixed [boys and girls].

There will be 3 grades:

A Grade:	for top teams [competitive players]
B Grade:	for experienced players
C Grade:	for teams which have never played before/beginner level or have less than one years' experience.

Each player plays the best of three games.

Each game is to 15 points, with 2-point advantage, and using American scoring [Point a Rally], i.e., a point is scored at the end of each rally.

Two points are awarded for each set, with the winning team [based on the total number of games won] gaining an additional two points. Maximum points available = 8

#### EQUIPMENT

A grade play with a single yellow dot ball, and B & C grade with a single blue dot.

All players must be wearing clean and non-marking court shoes.

All teams to supply their own playing ball and score sheets.

Protective eye wear [glasses/goggles] must be worn properly at all times and as part of health and safety. No eye wear means no play.

#### HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Comply with indoor venues evacuation & risk management plans.

Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.

Covid-19 all Schools must adhere to the Alert Level requirements in place at each venue used. These may include specific hygiene requirements, contact tracing, social distancing and possibly gathering size.

An entry fee of \$25.00 per team will be charged to the school account. Any late entries will incur a late fee of \$10.00 per team. No refund will be provided for teams that are subsequently withdrawn from the competition. Any defaults at SSC organised venues like Squash HQ will incur a cost.
