Rules Summary

EQUIPMENT

- Tables: Stag
- Nets: Stag
- Balls: Stag three star white which will be provided by Table Tennis Canterbury

ELIGIBILITY

- All members of a team must be pupils of the school [Year 9-13] and be under the age of 19 as at January 1 2021. For any dispensation of this rule please, contact the referee.
- A player may only be listed to play in one team.

ENTRIES

- All entries will be made via Enter NOW online entry system.
- The entry fee is \$35.00 per team. This can be paid to Table Tennis Canterbury.

- Players must play in their school representative uniforms or all team members must play in the same colour and style uniforms; no track pants or trousers.
- Players must wear non-marking sport shoes.

DRAWS

- Secondary Schools Tournament shall use a match system for three player teams.
- The format of play depends on the number of teams entered.
- All teams are guaranteed a minimum of two rounds/ games.
- Teams shall consist of up to a maximum of four players.
- Any team member is permitted to play in the doubles (if played), irrespective of whether they may be playing in singles matches in that contest.

DRUGS

- Glueing is only allowed in the allocated area.

AUTHORITY
