

2021 CANTERBURY SECONDARY SCHOOLS CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

DATE OF EVENT: Thursday 3 June

VENUE: Ascot Park, Ascot Ave, off Bower Ave.

TIME: First race starts at 12.40pm [note new start time for all Para grades]
Managers are asked to pick up race packs by 12.00pm from the caravan.

ENTRY: All entries will be done online via EnterNOW[www.enternow.co.nz] received by **Tuesday 1 June at 1.00pm**. Students must be under the age of 19 years as 31 December 2021 and fulfil the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sport as defined by the NZSSS Council. Students in Years 7 & 8 are not eligible to participate. This event is run per IAAF rules and athletes are prohibited from taking electronic devices (iPod & MP3 Players) into the competition arena.

Entries will be accepted from schools which are not partner schools of School Sport Canterbury, the Regional Sports Director's Office, but these entries will not be eligible to win trophies or other awards or be recognised in the final rankings of this Canterbury Secondary Schools event. Certificates will be printed to the first 3 individuals and top 3 teams in each grade and sent to schools after the event.
