2021 SOFTBALL

WEDNESDAY COMPETITION - TERM FOUR

Competition Dates

Competition begins on October 20 and concludes on Wednesday 10 November for Seniors: - 4 playing days and November 17 for Juniors – 5 playing days.

The competition format will be determined upon the number of teams.

Venues

Crosbie Park, Halswell Domain, Papanui Domain and School Diamonds, commencing at 3.15pm.

Team and Grade Conditions

Format will depend on number of team entries.

Mixed teams

Senior (for more experienced and/or senior players). Games are to be played over seven innings, or one hour.

Junior: is for students who are enrolled in Years 9 or 10, and who are under the age of 15 years as at 1 January 2021.

Umpires

The first named team provides the umpire.

Equipment

All catchers must wear a mask and a chest protector. Rubber balls will be used, unless coaches agree on leather. Footwear must be worn. Umpires must wear chest protectors.

Defaults

Teams which default, in addition to notifying opponents and any venues if applicable, are required to advise the Sports Director's Office that the team defaulting is capable of continuing in the competition in subsequent weeks. A simple explanation on the weekly results sheet sent in by schools will suffice (e.g., team members ill). Teams which default in one week will not be included in draws for the following week(s) until such an explanation is received. Their status will be indicated by "n/i – default" in subsequent draws information.

Results

Each school is now responsible for entering results directly into the Sports runner which is password protected and accessed via the SSC website homepage. www.canterbury.schoolsport.org.nz.

Results must be entered **1pm Thursday**. Heads of Sport will provide further information regarding this.

Cancellation

Cancellation information will be posted on our website by 10am, Up-dated at 12 noon on the day of competition. Heads of Sport will also be advised by email
