WEDNESDAY COMPETITION – TERM FOUR

Competition Dates

Competition begins on Wednesday 20 October and concludes on Wednesday 10 November for senior teams and Wednesday 17 November for Junior teams

Venues.

Super Touch is played at North Hagley Park with games commencing at 4.00pm and 4.45pm
Other grades will also play at North Hagley Park, prior to the start of Super Touch as well as, Carlton Corner and school touch fields.

A plan of the grounds at Hagley is available on the School Sport Canterbury website

Games commence at 3.15pm

Except for the mixed disability grade which plays at 1pm

Team and Grade Conditions

Super Touch: Now administered by Touch Canterbury, (entry restrictions apply)

Term 4 format to be confirmed.

Open Grade - Senior, and Mixed age grade teams

Intermediate Grade – for players who are in Years 9, 10 or 11 only

Junior Grade – for players in Year 9 or 10 only

Year 9 Grade – for players in Year 9 only

Mixed Disability Grade – Students in Special needs care.

A team consists of a maximum of fourteen players with six players on the field at any one time.

Mixed gender teams are only permitted in the Junior Mixed Year 9 & 10 [if entries permit], Mixed

Open grade and Boys Super Touch.

All Games are twenty minutes each way.

Any one player may play in only one team. NO Bare feet and NO rugby boots are permitted.

Referees

In grades other than Super Touch, each team named first on the draw provides a referee for the match. Schools with more than one team entered provide a referee for every two teams (excluding super touch teams) entered. Official referees will be appointed to Super Touch games. **Teams which fail to provide a referee as required will be automatically deducted 2 points at the start of the game (touch-downs)**

Equipment

Each team should be able to provide a Touch ball

The field should be marked out with cones (four required). This is a joint responsibility of both teams (two each).

Results

Each school is now responsible for entering results directly into the Sports runner which is password protected and accessed via the SSC website homepage. www.canterbury.schoolsport.org.nz by **1pm Thursday**. Heads of Sport will provide further information regarding this.

Other than SuperTouch there is no entry fee for weekly touch competitions.
