TENNIS

WEDNESDAY COMPETITION – SUMMER TERM FOUR 2021

Competition Dates

Competition begins on Wednesday 20 October and concludes on Wednesday 17 November - 5 playing days. Seniors conclude on 10 November with Juniors on 17 November.

Venues

Schools, Club Courts, commencing at 3.15pm. At least two courts should be available for each match.

Team and Grade Conditions

Each team consists of 4 players.

Premier grade and Division 1 & 2 matches consists of 4 singles and 2 doubles games.

Division 3 matches consist of 2 doubles games only.

Points are awarded as follows:

1 point for each game

3 points for the match

Total: 9 points

Premier Grade:(for the CJLTA Shield)

Best of 17 games (ie 9 up).

B Grade (Division 1 & 2), Junior (Division 1 & 2), Year 9 (Division 1 & 2) grades

A match consists of 4 singles and 2 doubles games.

Points are awarded as follows: 1 point for each game

3 points for the match

Total: 9 points

Best of 11 games ie 6-up with no tie-breaker

B (Division 3), Junior (Division 3) Year 9 (Division 3) grades

A match consists of 2 doubles games only. A match consists of 2 doubles games only.

Points are awarded 1 per game. Best of 17 games, ie 9-up.

Scenario 1: If a team **wins both** doubles matches the entered result will be **3-0**, with a bonus 1 point for the win.

Scenario 2: If a **each team wins one doubles match** each then a count back of games is needed. If a team wins on count back the entered result will be **2 -1**.

Scenario 3: If both teams are drawn on countback of games of 13 games all, the entered result will be remain a draw of **1-1**.

Junior Grade is for players who are enrolled in years 9 or 10 and who are under 15 years as at 1 January 2021. The year 9 grade is for players who are enrolled in Year 9 in 2021. Premier and B grades are open, for players who are aged under 19 as at 1 January 2021.

Umpires

All matches are self-umpired

HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Comply with indoor venues evacuation & risk management plans.
Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.
Covid-19 all Schools must adhere to the Alert Level requirements in place at each venue used. These may include specific hygiene requirements, contact tracing, social distancing and possibly gathering size.

Each team must supply at least one pair of good quality/condition balls.

Defaults

Teams which default, in addition to notifying opponents and any venues if applicable, are required to advise the Sports Director's Office that the team defaulting is capable of continuing in the competition in subsequent weeks.

Cancellation

Cancellation information will be posted on our APP & website by 10am, Up-dated at 12 noon on the day of competition. Heads of Sport will also be advised by email.

Cost There is no entry fee for the Wednesday Tennis competition in 2021, apart from games played at Wilding Park where it will cost \$5.00 per game for court hire. Schools who default will pay the entire court hire of \$10.00.
