COMPETITION DATES

Competition Begins on Wednesday 16 February and continues each Wednesday through until 23 March. **(6 playing days)**

The competition format will be determined upon the number of teams entered

VENUE

South Hagley Park, near the Netball courts

RULES AND GAME CONDITIONS

There is one grade for students in year 9 and above.

The optimum team size is 9 but more players may be included provided both teams have equal numbers.

Teams may comprise all boys, all girls, or any combination of boys and girls.

A copy of the Tee Ball rules and information is attached.

Games are scheduled to commence at 1.00pm and conclude by 2.00pm

UMPIRES

Each team is responsible for providing an umpire, either home plate or base, for each game.

EQUIPMENT

The first named team is responsible for providing a batting Tee and bases and ball

Each team is responsible for providing their own bats, gloves and any other safety equipment.

RESULTS

All schools are responsible for entering game results directly into the sports runner package which is password protected and can be accessed via the SSC website homepage.

These must be entered by 1pm the day following each game.

CANCELLATION

Schools will be notified by 11am if games are cancelled on any given day, and a push message notification will be sent via our free APP.

HEALTH & SAFETY

All students entering School Sport Canterbury delivered or sanctioned events and competitions will be required to be fully vaccinated. It will be the responsibility of the school to ensure only vaccinated students attend. Covid-19 all Schools must adhere to the Covid protection framework requirements in place at each venue used.
