- VENUE:** Nga Puna Wai Sports Hub, Halswell
- DATE:** Wednesday 9 March 2022
- TIME:** The meeting will start with an Officials and Managers meeting at 9.45am.  
The programme will commence *promptly* at 10.00am and should finish by 2.30pm.
- CANCELLATION:** If necessary a txt message will be sent to all school managers before 7am on the day, also published on the SSC App and website [www.canterbury.schoolsport.org.nz](http://www.canterbury.schoolsport.org.nz) (or by phone to Bill Grogan 0274 354 693)
- FOOTWEAR:** Spikes should be worn for track and jumps events  
Starting blocks will be supplied. Appropriate footwear is required for Shot Put, Discus and Javelin.
- GRADES:** As at 1 January 2022  
Under 13, Under 14, Under 15, Under 16; Under 19  
All competitors must be Under 19 as at 1 January 2022
- EVENTS:** Track: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, Relay.  
Field: High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, Discus, Javelin (Not U13)
- PROGRAMME:** This will be posted on the web-site [www.canterbury.schoolsport.org.nz](http://www.canterbury.schoolsport.org.nz)  
A named copy of the programme will be forwarded to Schools on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March and posted on the SSC website
- ENTRIES:** All entries will be taken on line and must be completed by 10am Thursday 3 March.  
**Please note that the on line system will only allow a max. of 3 events per student (plus relays) Any additional entries will need to be made directly to the Sports Director by email. A template form is available on the website for these additional entries. Please consider the welfare of the students and ‘Balance is Better’ in entering additional events.**  
**Under 13 grade athletes will also need to be entered manually this year**  
Schools must notify the RSD office of any changes prior to the event
- FACILITIES:** No changing room space is available at Nga Puna Wai.  
Adult supervision is a requirement for managing the students on the day of the event.  
**Other than water, no refreshments will be available at or near the venue**

**HEALTH & SAFETY**

All students entering School Sport Canterbury delivered or sanctioned events and competition will be required to be fully vaccinated. It will be the responsibility of the school to ensure only vaccinated students attend.  
Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Comply with risk management plans.  
Event officials are responsible for the safety of students during competition.  
Covid-19 all Schools must adhere to the Alert Level requirements in place at the time

These may include specific hygiene requirements, contact tracing, social distancing and possibly gathering size.

### **ATHLETICS 2022 PARTICIPATING SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS**

This event can only take place with the support of all schools. Each participating school is assigned a responsibility for this event. Any changes to these responsibilities are made at the Annual General Meeting of the Combined Country High Schools Sports Association held each year in June / July.

**EQUIPMENT:** Will be hired from Athletics Canterbury. Each school will have responsibility as listed. This includes getting the appropriate equipment **set up before 10.00am (school responsibility)** and putting it away at the conclusion of the event.

**OFFICIALS:** It is an entry requirement for every school that enters this event to supply the officials whether they are teachers, parents or senior students at their event. Each school is responsible for providing **senior pupils or parents** to assist them in the running of their field event(s). Some Athletic Canterbury officials are only there to assist the schools not to run the event. It is the school's responsibility for the event to run on time and the results handed in to the control room as soon as it has finished.
