



FOOTBALL FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES WEDNESDAY COMPETITION - WINTER TERM TWO 2022

COMPETITION DATES

Competition is set to begin on Wednesday 11 May, concludes on June 29 (8 playing days).
Wednesday 6 July is designated for SO Football Certificate Day

VENUES

The first 4 weeks will be played outdoors at Avonhead Park (or other venues by arrangement) The final 4 weeks will be played indoors at Pioneer Stadium. Special Olympic Certificate Day on July 6.

TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

There is one grade for secondary school students in year 9 and above. Optimum team size is 5 aside but more players may be included provided both teams have equal numbers. Teams may comprise all boys, all girls, or any combination of boys and girls. Unlimited substitutions are allowed. Teams with more than 5 players should use Intermediate sized fields for outdoor games

Games at Pioneer should be limited to 5 aside and are played on Basketball Courts

Games are scheduled to commence at 1.00pm 2 x 15 min halves.

REFEREES

First named team in the draw provides referee.

EQUIPMENT

First named team provides a suitable ball. Shin pads must be worn.

RESULTS

Schools will be responsible for entering their own results directly into Sports Runner Heads of Sport will be given full instruction re this process.

CANCELLATION

Cancellations will be advised to schools no later than 11am on the day of competition.
