Wednesday 19th & 26th October & 2nd November 2022

Papanui Petanque Club Terrain, 310 Sawyers Arms Rd

The 2022 petanque competition will be a lot different this year and consist of three playing Wednesdays. Papanui will be able to accommodate a maximum of 20 triples teams. There will be a section for those students with limited movement ability who may use Junior Petanque boule. All playing equipment is provided with the exception of boule delivery ramps which schools should provide for their own teams.

As the terrain can be very warm, students should wear comfortable clothing or sports uniform and a name badge which should clearly show both the student's name and Team name (e.g. Kelly and Mairehau A) and bring a hat, a water bottle and wear sunscreen. Teams will usually play two games during the approximate playing time 1.00 - 2.15 pm. Schools should arrive and check in by 12.45pm.

Caregivers

Schools should bring one caregiver/teacher per team. Papanui & Christchurch Petanque will be providing sufficient support for running the competition on Wednesday afternoons. Please drive in via the Papanui Club Main entrance. The Petanque Club is at the North East Corner and students can disembark close to the Club entrance. Vans should then proceed to park behind the Papanui Club's rooms in that carpark.

It would be helpful to the organizers if schools could indicate which of their teams contain wheelchair players and which teams require the use of the boule delivery ramp. This indication will assist in allowing sufficient movement room between the pistes and more efficient use of the boule delivery ramps. Papanui Club is shingled so it is probable that students with limited mobility will play from one end only.

Health & Safety

All equipment must be safe to use. All playing surfaces must be in a safe condition for games. Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play. Papanui Petanque does not have a mobility toilet but one unisex toilet is available. Adjacent to where the vans would be parking there is a ramp and mobility toilets in the Papanui Club.

Entry

Schools are required to enter online via EnterNOW [www.enternow.co.nz], closing on Friday 30 September 1pm.

Defaults

Teams which default, in addition to notifying opponents and any venues if applicable, are required to advise the Sports Director's Office that the team defaulting is capable of continuing in the competition in subsequent weeks.

Cancellation

Cancellation information will be posted on our APP & website by 10.00am, Updated at 12 noon on the day of competition. Heads of Sport will also be advised by email
