

## INDOOR FOOTBALL

### WEDNESDAY COMPETITION – TERM ONE 2023

#### COMPETITION DATES

Competition begins on 15 February and concludes on Wednesday 22 March – 6 playing days.

#### VENUES

Games will be played in both school gyms (mostly) and some commercial venues

#### TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

There are two grades - senior for boys/girls/mixed teams of any age (Under 18) and Junior for boys/girls/mixed teams comprising students in Years 9 or 10 only and who are Under 15 on 1 January 2022. Separate competitions will be held for boys, girls and mixed teams if entry numbers permit, otherwise, all mixed teams will be placed in the boys competition.

Mixed teams must consist of boys & girls **not** meaning mixed year levels.

A team consists of five players, with unlimited substitutions.

Games are of 30 minutes duration played in two halves, and are scheduled to commence at 3.15, 3.45 and 4.15pm at commercial venues, with 3.15pm start times when at school gyms.

#### COMPETITION SCORING

Win = 4, loss = 0, draw = 2, win by default = 6, bonus 1 for every 5 goals scored.

#### REFEREES

Referees will be supplied by the venue and host school.

#### EQUIPMENT

All equipment is supplied. Fluffy indoor football to be used.

White (non-marking) soled shoes are to be worn. Shin pads must be worn behind socks.

#### HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue.

Schools must comply with the evacuation & risk management plan at the venue.

All equipment must be safe to use. All surfaces must be in a safe condition for games.

Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.

**Covid-19** - School Sport Canterbury will follow and adhere to the guidelines provided by the government on the day of competition. All Schools must adhere to the requirements in place at each venue used. These may include specific hygiene requirements, contact tracing, social distancing and possibly gathering size.

#### RESULTS

#### **DEFAULT**

Teams which default, in addition to notifying opponents and any venues if applicable, are required to advise the Sports Director's Office that the team defaulting via email, and is capable of continuing in the competition in subsequent weeks.

#### **CANCELLATION**

Cancellation information will be posted on our APP & website by 10am, up-dated at 12 noon on the day of competition. Heads of Sport will also be advised by email.

#### **ENTRY**

Schools are required to enter online via EnterNOW [[www.enternow.co.nz](http://www.enternow.co.nz)], closing on Wednesday 8 February at 1.00pm.

#### **COST**

Entry Fee: Schools will be charged \$37.00 per game played in a commercial venue. This will be charged to School account.

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
