

TABLE TENNIS WEDNESDAY COMPETITION - WINTER 2023

COMPETITION DATES

Competition begins on Wednesday 10 May, continues until 28 June, resumes on 19 July and concludes on 16 August [12 playing days]. The competition format will be determined by the number of teams entered. Games begin at 3.15pm.

ENTRY

To be entered via EnterNOW system by the close of entries date of Wednesday 3 May at 5.00pm.

VENUES

Table Tennis Stadium: 294 Blenheim Road, Christchurch

DUTY SCHOOL

A school will be named as the DUTY school each week. Duties consist of having an adult present throughout and

- ensuring the Association's facilities and equipment are treated with care.
- ensuring all players have the appropriate footwear. [see details below]
- ensuring games commence as soon as practical and that they progress so as to be completed by 4.30pm.

TEAM AND GRADE CONDITIONS

Teams consist of 4 players, boys, girls, or boys and girls combined [mixed], playing in ranked order.

There are 3 grades: A Grade: for top teams

B Grade: for experienced players

C Grade: for teams which have at least three players who have never

played before

A match consists of 4 singles and two doubles sets

All A grade games are the best of 5 games. B & C grades play the best of 3 games.

A set consists of best of 3 games, first to 11 points, with a 2 point advantage. The service changes after every two serves for B & C grades.

Match points are awarded as follows: Total 9 points

1 point for each set

3 points for the winner [on count back of games, if even then points to determine winner]

This competition will be administered according to School Sport Canterbury Competition Policies.

EQUIPMENT

Players MUST wear white-soled/ non marking shoes, please ensure the soles are clean before entering the stadium. Black soled and school shoes are not permitted.

Teams are to have their own bats, and each team should be able to supply at least one ball ready already to begin playing as soon as they arrive.

RESULTS

All schools are responsible for in-putting their own results directly into the SportsRunner draw package by 1.00 pm the day following each game.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. All schools must comply with indoor venues evacuation & risk management plans. Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.
