Health & Safety - Covid-19

All students entering School Sport Canterbury delivered or sanctioned events and competitions will be required to be fully vaccinated in term one. It will be the responsibility of the school to ensure only vaccinated students attend. Under the CPF there may be limits in terms of gathering sizes and entries able to be received to ensure everyone involved is in a safe environment and within the Sport NZ guidelines. Facemasks are mandatory at all times when not participating / playing, eating or drinking, except at pools.
