

# Touch Canterbury Super Touch Information Booklet for Term 4 2023



Touch Canterbury welcomes you back to another Term of Super Touch for Term 4 2023

**Grades:** Secondary Schools Boys/Mixed Open

Secondary Schools Girls Open

Please note that all grades are subject to a minimum of 4 team entries. If we have insufficient team numbers in any grade we will place teams into a suitable grade.

All grades are 6 a side and you can have 10 reserves in each game totalling 16 players. Mixed teams can play in the boys section under boys rules (i.e. no minimum number of girls required).

The competition will be held on Wednesday afternoons with two rounds, 4.00pm and 4.35pm.

Games will be played at the Bob Deans Fields, North Hagley Park.

Draws will be based on number of entries per grade. Grades may be split into 2 sections. Byes may occur if there are an odd number of teams.

## **Competition Dates & Referee Info:**

The season will commence on Wednesday 18th October 2023 and finish on the 22nd November 2023. The Finals format will be sent out with the draw when we know how many teams have entered each grade. If a week is cancelled due to bad weather the draw will skip to the next week's game.

Teams are required to referee their own games. If agreed upon by the other coach you are more than welcome to referee half a game each or one person do the whole game. A basic Referee Video is on the Super Touch Website.

You will also be required to take your own time. Games are 30mins in duration, 2x 15min halves with a 2 minute half time.

Please be organised and ready before the start time of your game.

#### **Cancellations:**

#### **Eligibility of Players:**

School sport eligibility applies.

### **Dress Standard and Match Points:**

- Each team's players MUST wear the same colour t-shirt when playing;
- It is essential that players have identification numbers (preferably no numbers higher than 16) on the back of their playing shirt;
- Shoes should be worn at all times by both players and referees;
- No jewellery or watches may be worn.

Match Points will be allocated as follows; 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss. No points will be awarded for a default/forfeit and in the event of a default/forfeit the non-offending team will be awarded the win.
