



5 ASIDE FOOTBALL

WEDNESDAY COMPETITION – TERM ONE 2024

COMPETITION DATES

Competition begins on Wednesday 21 February and concludes on Wednesday 27 March - 5 playing days (no play Wednesday 20 March due to Summer Tournament Week)

VENUE

Games will be played at English Park, Cranford Street

TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

There are six grades – Senior (year 11-13) boys/girls/mixed teams and Junior (year 9 & 10) boys/girls/mixed teams. Separate competitions will only be held for boys, girls and mixed [gender] teams if entry numbers permit, otherwise all mixed teams will be placed in the boys competition. Mixed teams must consist of mixed gender, **not** mixed year levels.

Games are of 30 minutes duration played in two x 15-minute halves and are scheduled to commence at either 3.15pm or 3.55pm (3.55pm round will only be used if required due to entry numbers). [Mainland Football 5 aside rules](#) will apply.

COMPETITION SCORING [points]

Win = 4, loss = 0, draw = 2, win by default = 4

REFEREES

Both teams are to provide a referee to officiate half the game each.

EQUIPMENT

Schools must supply their own ball.

Players must wear clean, Astro Turf suitable footwear.

Shin pads are compulsory.

HEALTH & SAFETY

All equipment must be safe to use. All courts & surfaces must be in a safe condition for games. Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.

RESULTS

All schools are responsible for in-putting their own results directly into the SportsRunner draw package by 1.00 pm the day following each game.

DEFAULTS

Teams which default, in addition to notifying opponents and any venues if applicable, are required to advise the Regional Sports Director's Office via email that the team defaulting can continue in the competition in subsequent weeks.

CANCELLATION

Cancellation information will be posted on our APP & website by 12 noon on the day of competition. Heads of Sport will also be advised by email.

ENTRY

Schools are required to enter online via EnterNOW [www.enternow.co.nz], entries close on Wednesday 14 February at 5.00pm. This competition will be administered in line with School Sport Canterbury Competition Policies.

COST

Entry Fee: \$60 per team Ex GST - This will be charged to School account.
