PURPOSE

The purpose of The Willows Girls Secondary School Cricket Competition in Term 1 2024, is to keep players engaged throughout their secondary school years, provide more coaching opportunities and to foster growth to provide sustainability in player numbers. This purpose has evolved from recognising that there is a gap in girls' cricket at the secondary school level.

Our focus for players in this competition is to:

- 1. Build connections,
- 2. Development opportunities,
- 3. Enjoyment

VENUE

To be held at multiple venues around Canterbury. We will utilize school pitches if available and local grounds. Teams will be notified of these when draws get released.

TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

Games will be played 9-aside; however, it is encouraged if both teams can field a team of 11 then the format is played 11-aside.

The format is T15 with games commencing at 4.15pm. Every player must contribute to the team's performance. To ensures this happens the following playing conditions need to be followed:

- The same player must not open the bowling and batting,
- Once a bowler reaches 3 wickets their bowling is maxed out.
- Batters must be retired at 25 runs.
- 8 ball max overs, except for the last over of the innings.
- Rolling subs are allowed can have non-bowler/non-batter.

A more in-depth breakdown of playing rules will be distributed to schools closer to the start date (Thursday 15th February).

COMPETITION SCORING [points]

Due to this being the four weeks leading up to Gillette Venus we want the girls to focus on their own individual and team development so at this stage there won't be a points system.

UMPIRES & SCORERS

Each team is to provide an umpire. This can be an older student, player, or parent etc. Teams are responsible for scoring. Games will be loaded into PlayHQ so online scoring can take place if preferred.

EQUIPMENT

- Schools are to provide a set of stumps.
- Match balls will be provided, thanks to the sponsorship of the Willows Cricket Club.
- Players/schools are to bring their own playing equipment, warm up gear etc.

HEALTH & SAFETY

All equipment must be safe to use. All grounds & pitches must be in a safe condition for games. Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Game officials are responsible for the safety of players during play. A RAM form has been completed and can be distributed to schools if required.

RESULTS

All schools are responsible for ensuring that results get loaded into PlayHQ by 5pm the following day.

Cancellation information will be sent via email to all Team Managers and/or coaches by 1pm on the day of competition.
