YEAH! GIRLS SMASH

THURSDAY – TERM ONE 2024

PURPOSE

The purpose of Yeah! Girls Smash is to provide a modified cricket playing opportunity to Secondary School Girls. Yeah! Girls Smash aims to grow female participation in cricket by providing a fun, inclusive and social environment for girls to play with their friends.

COMPETITION DATES

<u>VENUE</u>

Games will be played at St Andrews College on their sports field.

TEAM AND GAME CONDITIONS

- Games are short and action packed 60-minute games starting at 4.30pm. With a warm up activity facilitated by Canterbury Cricket at 4.15pm. This format provides equal opportunities for players to bat, bowl and field.
- Schools will enter 8-aside teams who will join together for x4 Thursday afternoons to develop skills and play a game of pairs cricket using a soft-ball and plastic equipment.
- Girls may register as individuals should their school not have enough for a team. Everyone is
- welcome. We will combine teams if needed on the day to ensure all girls who turn up play.
- No experience necessary, perfect for beginners or those wanting to play a social format with
- their mates.

COMPETITION SCORING [points]

This is a participation-based format, where we just want girls to get involved and try something new. No formal results will be kept.

GAME FACILITATOR

Teams are asked to provide one person who can be in charge of scoring/umpiring for the game. No cricket knowledge is needed. This could be a teacher, parent, senior student or older sibling. If this is going to be a barrier for your school please get in touch with Gabriella.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment will be provided by CCA. Teams are encouraged to wear their school colours.

HEALTH & SAFETY

All equipment used will be plastic and soft equipment only. Games will be spread out enough that they don't interfere with each other. If other sports are using the same grounds event organisers will ensure that Yeah Girls Smash has its own identified area, away from other sports. Schools are responsible for the safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Game officials along with CCA staff are responsible for the safety of students during play. CCA staff will have first aid equipment available throughout the period of time that students are taking part in Yeah! Girls Smash (4.15pm – 5.30pm). A RAM form has been completed and can be distributed to schools if required.

Cancellation information will be sent via email to the nominated schools team contact by 1pm on the day of Yeah! Girls Smash.
