#### Aims of the Competition.

- To give students the opportunity to compete in a competition in a sport of their choice.
- In the spirit of Fair Play riders will be competing on a mount on which they normally compete at the height at which they normally compete.
- Coaches and/or managers are expected to be assured that their riders have already competed at the height at which their riders are entered.
- The competition will be run under ESNZ rules, the links are given here -

### **General Information**

- The committee reserves the right to select the teams to enter if the competition is oversubscribed. This may mean some schools are restricted to the number of teams they can enter.
- All riders must be current students at the school on the day of competition. The competition is open to students from **Year 9 to Year 13**.
- One horse per rider, one rider per horse.
- Horses and ponies must compete in their current SJ height. Ie if you are competing at or above 105cm then you must enter 105cm for your team. No downgrading of combinations allowed. A combination that has competed at 105cm or above cannot enter the 95cm or 85cm classes.
- School Contacts/Team managers/Team Coaches are responsible for ensuring all riders know the rules, know their duties and complete their allocated duties.

- Any rider requiring a yard or teams wanting to camp on the grounds must arrange this with the secretary and pay for this direct to the Secretary who will pass on the funds to NEC.
- Riders who are camping at the grounds are expected to help with setting up on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> of April once they arrive. This will be part of their duties.
- Please bring your back number holders and print off your own numbers.
- All spectators, riders, and other personnel are on the grounds at their own risk.
- All riders must have an adult on the grounds who is personally responsible for them. This is not the function of the team manager.

In all SSC and sanctioned competitions and championship events, entry priority will be given to SSC partner schools. Entries from non- partner schools outside the region will be allowed, but only accepted where space and time permits.

## **Show Jumping Competition**

- Each team of 4 riders will have one rider at each height (85 cm, 95 cm and 105 cm) and one other rider at any height.
- Each rider will ride 2 rounds of show jumping.
- Winners of classes will receive their ribbons at the end of each class of the competition with final team competition rosettes awarded at an unmounted prizegiving at the end of the day.
- Riders will compete in catalogue order.

### **Show Hunter**

The show hunter classes are open to all riders entered in the Show jumping competition. You must ride the horse you rode for the Show jumping.

- There are two heights on offer. Lower 70-80cm and Higher 80-90cm.
- You may ride only one round of SH. You will need to choose the height you wish to ride.
- The Lower ring will run first then the Higher ring.
- You will be eliminated if you use gear that is not allowed in the Show hunter. If in doubt, ask!
- The competition will be an equitation class over jumps.
- There is no additional charge for entry in the show hunter class.
- The winning school will be made up of the 4 best placed riders from that school who did either height.

#### **Entries**

All entries are to be made by the teacher in charge. We will not accept private entries.

Payment of entry fees is by direct credit only, to the SJ bank account, **ANZ 06 0665 0558981 00** under "Canterbury Interschools Show jumping." Provide school name please.

These funds **must** be received before any entries can be accepted. No rider will be able to start unless the fees are paid in full.

Entry fees are \$280.00 per team or \$70.00 per rider if a team is not complete. In entering a student to compete you are guaranteeing that the student is enrolled and attending your school.

Schools that can't make up a team can enter individual riders and we will place them into a team. Please let the secretary know before you enter an incomplete team.

All teams are expected to complete two duties per team entered, the link for that sheet will be sent to schools as they enter. Schools not completing the google sheet will be allocated duties by the secretary for the event.
