Team members <u>may only be entered by their respective schools</u> for this team's event. Help is available on EvoEvents.

RULES and CONDITIONS.

Competing schools are to be part of the recognised School Sport Canterbury area.

- 1. Riders and horses or ponies need not be registered with ESNZ.
- 2. The competition is run under ESNZ rules. https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/dressage-rules/
- 3. This is a non-grading day.
- 4. The Officials reserve the right to make, alter, add, delete etc, to the program.
- 5. Teams event 1 Rider, 1 Horse; 1 Horse, 1 Rider.
- 6. Limit of four teams per school may be entered, but these will be subject to ballot if more than 30 teams are entered
- 7. A competitive team will consist of four riders on ponies or hacks. Two riders ride two tests at Level 1 and two riders ride two Level 2 tests.
- 8. Teams will be of four riders with all four scores counting from both tests. Teams with less than 4 riders may enter but will be non- competitive as all 4 scores count towards the final result.
- 9. In all SSC and sanctioned competitions and championship events, entry priority will be given to SSC partner schools. Entries from non-partner schools outside the region will be allowed, but only accepted where space and time permits. As a general rule the hierarchy for acceptance of teams into events will be:
 - a. A teams from SSC partner schools
 - b. B teams from SSC partner schools
 - c. Composite teams from SSC partner schools
 - d. A teams from non-partner schools
 - e. Composite teams from non-partner schools

10. ALL TESTS CAN BE CALLED

- 11. **We will NOT be providing back numbers**. All riders must have either a back number, arm band number or number on the horses bridle or saddle blanket. Please print your own number.
- 12. You must provide 2 named helpers per team for the day of competition. A google document will be circulated for people to fill out. **Entries will not be accepted without these helpers**. A job sheet will be emailed to all teams when the draw goes out.
- 13. Rosettes from 1st 6th overall placing to be awarded
- 14. Arenas will be 60 x 20m.
- 15. Team manager is responsible for riders' gear and safety. There is no gear check. Although there will be random checks on the day and all riders must be wearing a yellow tagged helmet.
- 16. Whip lengths: Horses: 120cm (including flapper) Ponies: 100cm (including flapper).
- 17. Students from Year 9 13
- 18. If a school can't enter a full team you can a enter part team of 2 or more riders and the event secretary will try and combine schools to create a full team. This means that schools with full team/s cannot also enter a part team.
- 19. In the unlikely event Cancellation should be required team managers will be emailed/ text. Will also be on Facebook upcoming events page.
- 20. The draw will be posted on Evo Events and School Sport Canterbury once finalised and all helpers names are in. This means all riders have access to the draw.
- 21. Riders compete at their own risk. The organisers accept no responsibility for accident, injury or loss.
- 22. Riders remain the responsibility of their schools. There will be no marshals so it is rider and manager responsibility to be on time at the correct arenas. Please make sure you look at the map and draw provided to avoid confusion.
- 23. Dress: either normal dressage attire or school team uniform.

- 24. Payment of entry fees to be direct credited into ASB 12 3153 0074143 00 at the time of entry. Payment for full team **not individual payments** (school to pay team entry of \$280 and collect their own individual payments). Entries will not be accepted into the final draw unless full payment is made.
- 25. By confirming team entry you are accepting all of the above rules and regulations. Health and safety plan will be available on school sport Canterbury website along with a copy of these rules and regulations.
- Scratchings: 80% of your entry fee will only be refunded if you can provide a vet or doctors certificate.
