INDIVIDUAL SQUASH CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024

- Date: Saturday 18 May from 2pm (1 game) Sunday 19 May from 9am (2 games)
- Venue: Hoon Hay Squash Club / Squash HQ, 8 Takaro Avenue, Sockburn
- **Grades:** This competition is for individuals.
- **Format**: A match consists of five games. A match is the best of 5 games up to 11 points, PAR (Point-A-Rally) Scoring, winning by a clear two-point margin. Players are guaranteed three matches in full draws.
- **Entry:** All entries are to be done online via EnterNOW system. Entries close on Monday 13th May at 1.00pm. Students must be under the age of 18 years as 1 January 2024 and fulfil the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sport as defined by the School Sport New Zealand. Students in Years 7 & 8 are not eligible to participate.

Entries will be accepted from schools which are not partner schools of the Canterbury Secondary Schools Sports Director's Office, but these entries will not be eligible to win trophies or other awards or be recognised in the final rankings of this Canterbury Secondary Schools event.

- Ball: Single Yellow Dot for all divisions
- Levels: If both players are registered with Squash New Zealand, the results will be submitted to Squash Levels. If only 1 player is registered with Squash New Zealand, the results will not be submitted to Squash Levels

Health & Safety:

Schools are responsible for the health and safety of their students in transit to and from and at the venue. Comply with indoor venues evacuation & risk management plans. Game officials are responsible for the safety of students during play.
